You cared deeply for your family and always worked hard to provide for us. We will remember your wisdom, kindness, and the strength you showed throughout your life.

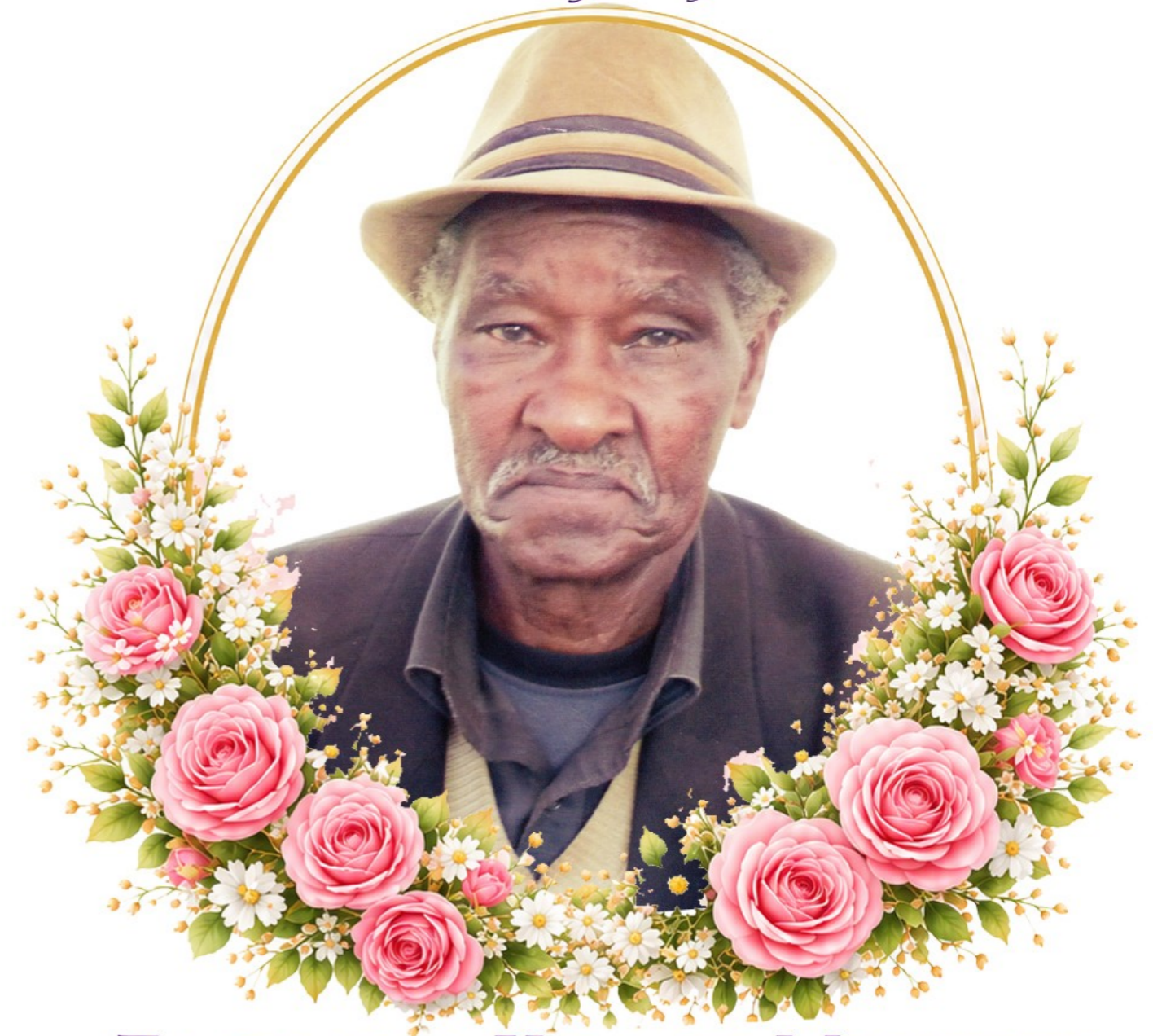
Though saying goodbye is painful, we thank God for the time we shared with you. Your memories will remain in our hearts forever.
